

FRONT RANGE PASSENGER RAIL

PLANNING A NEW TRANSPORTATION OPTION FOR COLORADO'S FRONT RANGE.

Rethink your “local.” As communities grow, a new passenger train will connect Front Range Coloradans to opportunities, adventure, and each other. Are you ready to leave delays and heavy traffic behind? We are too, so we’re planning for a future of safe, reliable, and climate-conscious travel.



WHERE: Initially offering service from Fort Collins through Denver and south to Pueblo, the Front Range Passenger Rail (FRPR) intercity train service has the long-term vision of connecting Colorado to New Mexico and Wyoming.



WHY: From 2020 to 2050, an additional 3 million people are expected to live and commute along the Front Range in Colorado. FRPR will provide a relaxed, efficient, and safe transportation option that connects key destinations in our extraordinary state.



WHEN: After about a decade of study and planning, the FRPR District is currently evaluating routes, stations, service, infrastructure, operations, costs, and financing. The first train could be operational in the next 10-15 years.



HOW: The Colorado Legislature created the FRPR District to construct and operate a passenger rail system along the Front Range. Using existing tracks shared with freight railroads, our partnerships with transportation providers, elected officials, and community leaders minimize costs and accelerate the service start date. New passenger rail programs and funding established through the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law makes this a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to implement FRPR.

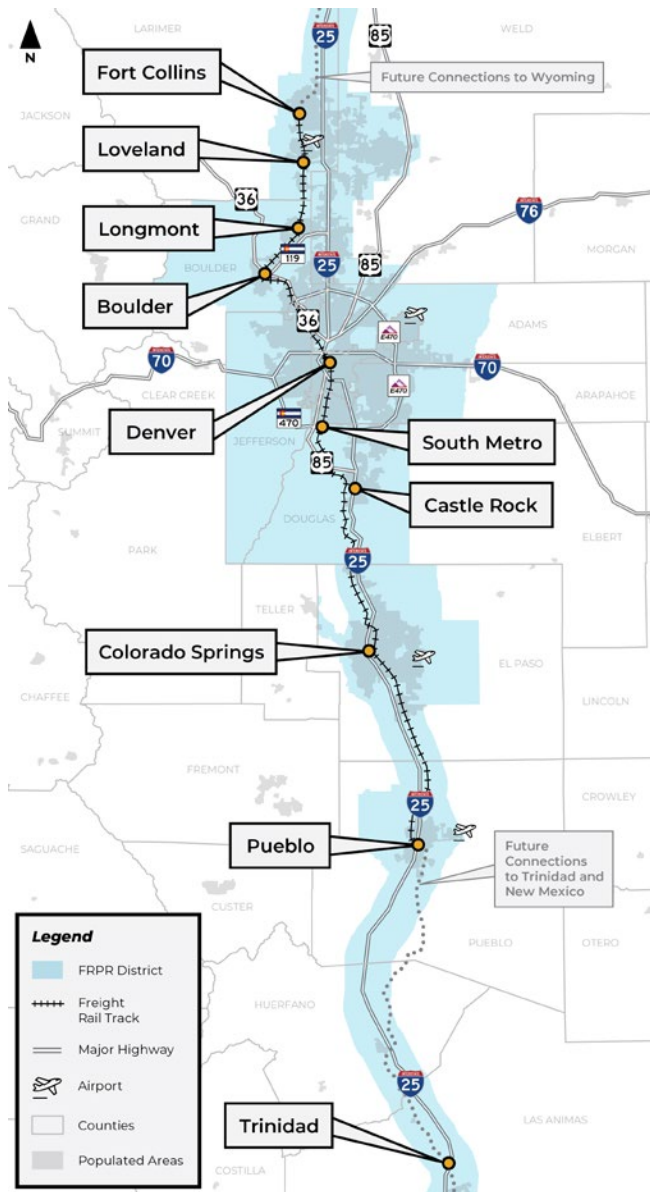
